

WALNUT HILLS SWIM CLUB POOL RULES

Parents: Please see that your children understand these rules, and the consequences for breaking them. Rules are for the safety and enjoyment of all.

1. Keep off all framework, supports, lane ropes, etc.
2. No horseplay, running, pushing, etc. in the pool area. No jumping across corners of the pool.
3. Only one diver on the diving board at a time. A ten second limit per person.
4. For the convenience of the adults and for safety reasons, children will observe a 15 minute rest period each hour.
NO EXCEPTIONS!
5. During the 15 minute rest period, the main pool may be used by the lifeguards, adults over 18, or pre-school children with an adult in constant attendance.
6. Only supervised children 5 and under are allowed in the baby pool.
7. All infants and any children who are not fully potty trained must wear swim diapers.
8. Children 6 and under must have an adult accompany them to use the restroom.
9. Adults over 18 years old have priority of using chairs. You may also bring your own chairs.
10. No glass of any kind is allowed in the pool area.
11. No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the pool area during swimming hours.
12. Only authorized personnel may be in the office or filter and equipment rooms.
13. No cross-pool diving in the deep end of the pool.
14. No floatation devices in the deep end.
15. Noodles may not be used to strike anyone.
16. No animals are allowed in the pool area.
17. Children under 10 cannot be left at the pool unattended.
18. Deep end swimmers must be able to swim one width of the pool independently.
19. Profanity will not be tolerated.
20. The pool may be closed due to weather. The pool will automatically close when thunder is heard or lightning is sighted in the area.
21. Only emergency phone calls will be permitted.
22. Babysitters and caregivers may only be at the pool when the parents are not available. If they come with the parents they are considered guests and must pay the guest fee.
23. Mermaid tails are not allowed in the pool.

Lifeguards are responsible for the safety of those swimming. Therefore, you must listen to them.

- a. First offense: a verbal warning.
- b. Second offense: 2nd verbal warning/10 minute time-out.
- c. Third offense: Will be sent home for a 24 hour period.
- d. If there are any further offenses or refusal to listen, the member must appear before a three person committee of the pool board members.
